If you want to keep your benefits during your appeal, your request must be postmarked or faxed **on or before the effective date of the intended action**. If the Grievance and Appeal Committee decides that My Choice Wisconsin's decision was correct, you may need to repay the extra benefits that you got between the time you asked for your appeal and the time that the Grievance and Appeal Committee makes a decision. However, if it would cause you a large financial burden, you might not be required to repay this cost.

Check this box if you would like to request the same services to continue during your appeal.

You have a right to a free copy of the information in your case file related to your appeal. Information means documents, records and other related material including any new or additional information My Choice Wisconsin gathers during your appeal.
