What is Medicare Dual Advantage?

Medicare Dual Advantage (HMO SNP) is a Medicare Advantage plan for people who qualify for both Medicaid and Medicare. This plan helps coordinate your healthcare needs with no monthly premiums or deductibles. Your plan includes prescription medications and you'll have access to unique program benefits like dental and vision coverage and a monthly allowance to spend through our over-the-counter catalog.

My Choice Wisconsin operates in 55 counties and offers Family Care, Family Care Partnership, Medicare Dual Advantage, Medicaid SSI, and BadgerCare Plus. With offices in 14 cities throughout Wisconsin, we strive to be a valued partner within all the communities we serve.

Part A: Hospital Visits & Expenses

Part B: Doctor Visits & Tests

Some extra benefits you'll enjoy:



Over-the-Counter (OTC) Catalog

\$100 per month with roll-over to spend on items such as OTC medications and personal care items. These include incontinence pads, vitamins, pain relievers – over 400 items to choose from!



Dental Coverage

\$2,500 per year in dental coverage beyond Medicaid for exams, cleanings, x-rays, crowns, and fillings. You can even visit a non-Medicaid dentist if there is not one convenient to your location.



Vision Coverage

\$150 per year toward eyeglasses and contacts beyond your Medicaid benefit.



Personal Emergency Response Button (PERS)

If falls or health-related emergencies ever become a concern for you, the plan will provide you with an emergency button for your safety.



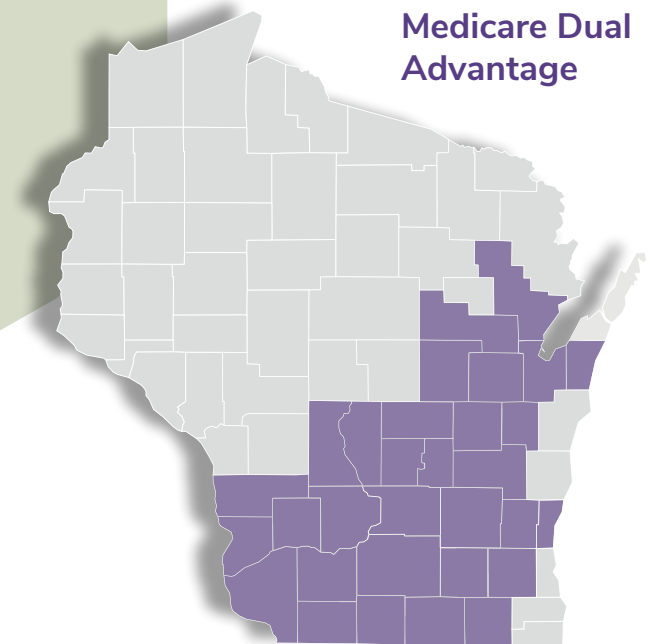
Assistance with Medical Services and Questions
