The Medicaid SSI program helps adults who qualify for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) coordinate their healthcare needs. At My Choice Wisconsin, our members are our top priority – you and your care coordinator develop your care plan and choose the best way to receive your health services. My Choice Wisconsin supports the Medicaid SSI program in 39 counties in Wisconsin.

My Choice Wisconsin operates in 55 counties and offers Family Care, Family Care Partnership, Medicare Dual Advantage, Medicaid SSI, and BadgerCare Plus. With offices in 14 cities throughout Wisconsin, we strive to be a valued partner within all the communities we serve.

### Preventative Medical Care and Screening Services

immunizations, mammograms, hearing services



### Urgent Care

care when your clinic is closed for infections and injuries that are not an emergency



### Hospitalizations

hospital stays for emergency and non-emergency care



### Medical Equipment

wheelchair, walker, oxygen, diabetic shoes



### Medical Supplies

bandages, respiratory and injection supplies



### Mental Health

AODA counseling, physical psychiatrist office visits, hospitalizations, day treatment



### Home Health and Personal Care Services



### Reproductive Support

family planning counseling, pregnancy and delivery support



### Vision

surgical and doctor visits including one pair of eyeglasses and one replacement eyeglass per 12 months

# Am I Eligible to Join?

## Who Can Join My Choice Wisconsin Medicaid SSI

- 19 years of age or older
- You qualify for or receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) due to a disability determination
- You qualify for or receive state Medicaid assistance determined by income and assets
- You live within the counties Medicaid SSI is offered. My Choice Wisconsin supports the Medicaid SSI program in **39 counties**
