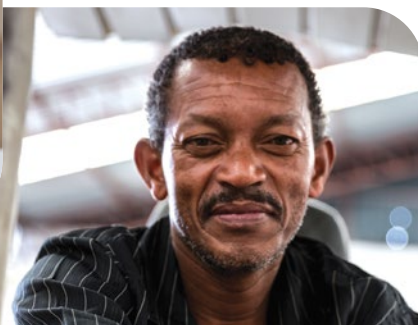

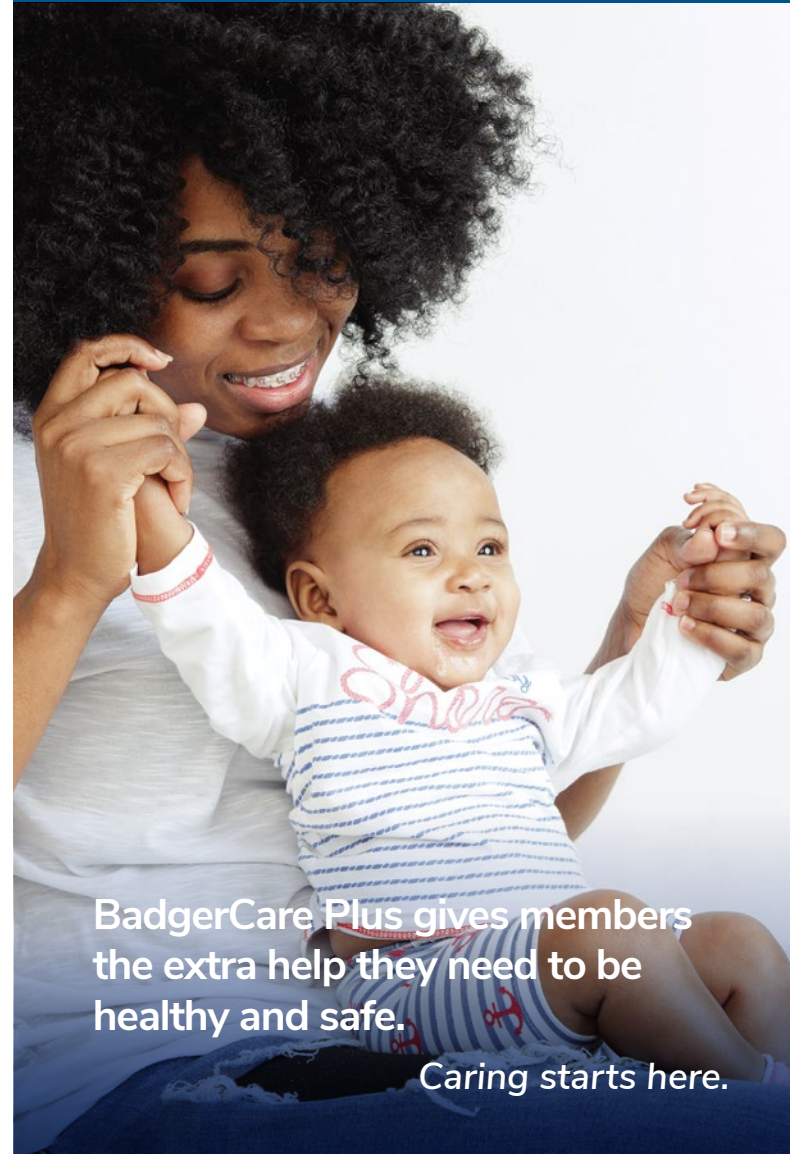

Am I Eligible to Join?

Who Can Join BadgerCare Plus?

- You qualify for or receive state Medicaid assistance determined by income and assets.
- You live within the counties BadgerCare Plus is offered. My Choice Wisconsin supports the BadgerCare Plus program in **27 counties** in Wisconsin.
- If you are currently insured, you might still be eligible.

Enrollees can include:

- Children
- Pregnant women
- Adults with dependent children under the age of 19
- Adults ages 19 to 64 years old
- Adults ages 18 to 25 who were in foster care when they turned 18
