What is Partnership?

The Partnership program helps frail elders and adults with disabilities with higher care needs coordinate their medical, health, and long-term care services. Members enrolled in the Partnership program work with a local Care Team consisting of a Care Manager and a Registered Nurse, plus anyone else the member wants involved, to create a personalized plan that will help them live their fullest life as independently as possible. My Choice Wisconsin supports the Partnership program in 12 counties in Wisconsin.

What do we do?

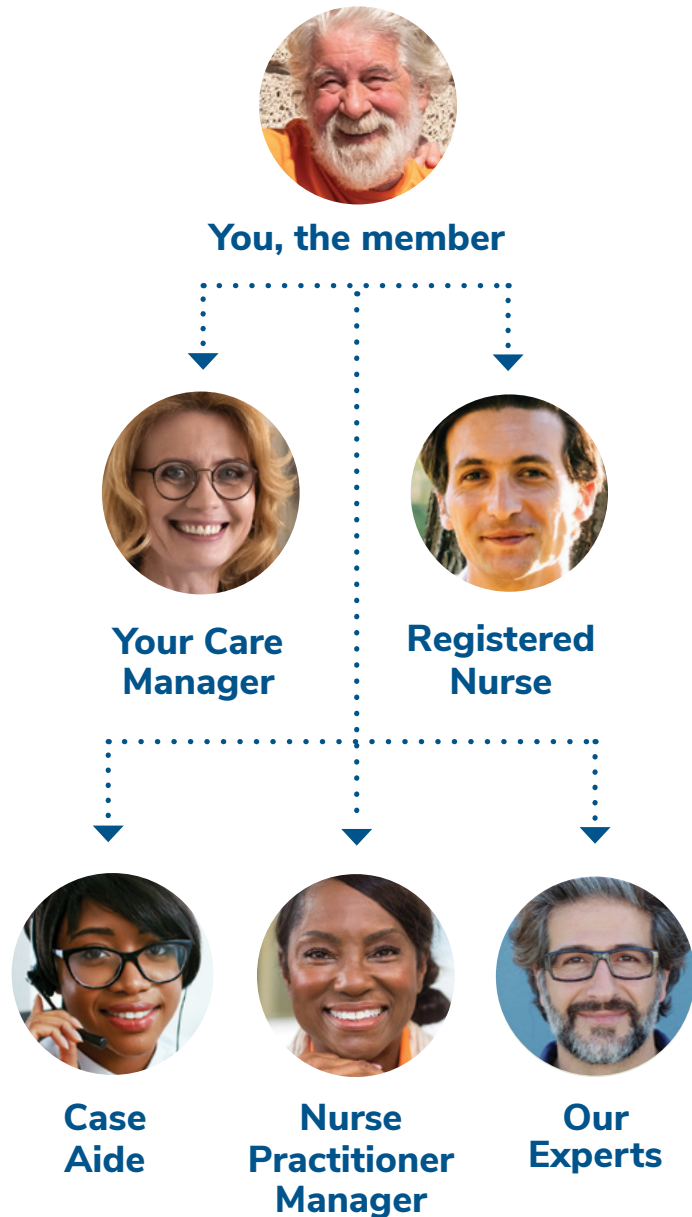

My Choice is an independent, non-stock corporation that provides Medicare and Medicaid programs to over 44,000 individuals, families, frail elders, and adults with intellectual, developmental, and physical disabilities in 67 counties throughout Wisconsin.

Preventive Medical Care, etc.
annual wellness visits, flu shots, doctor appointments when you are sick



Medical Equipment and Supplies
walkers, blood sugar monitors, oxygen equipment



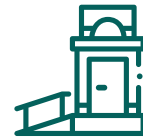
Lab, Xray, etc.
blood work, xrays for illness or to determine fractures and breaks



Dental and Vision
coverage for Medicare dental and vision services



Home Care
personal cares and skilled nursing



Home Modifications
railings, ramps, adaptive fixtures



Job Skills Training
training for the workplace and vocational support



Self-Directed Services
Be your own boss and choose how and who provides your services



Transportation
specialized transportation to your medical appointments



Therapy Services
counseling, physical therapy, speech & language therapy

Services are determined based on the individual's level of needs ("functional eligibility") as determined by the Long-Term Care Functional Screen. Services must be necessary to support your long-term care outcomes and ensure your health and safety.

Am I Eligible to Join?

Who Can Join My Choice Wisconsin Partnership

- 18 years of age or older with intellectual, physical, or developmental disabilities OR 65 years of age or older
- You qualify for or receive state Medicaid assistance determined by income and assets
- You meet certain eligibility requirements determined by the long-term care functional screen
- You live within the counties Partnership is offered. My Choice Wisconsin supports the Partnership program in **12 counties**
