2023 Quality Plan Results



Each year, the Quality Department develops a work plan with goals and outcomes for My Choice Wisconsin's Family Care & Partnership programs to achieve. The goals are chosen based on the results of the previous year's plan evaluation, internal and external audits, feedback from members/caregivers/providers and other data sources that may indicate the need to improve performance. The plan serves as a roadmap for corrective actions and Performance Improvement Projects, and it provides a tracking mechanism for Quality Department staff to monitor progress toward reaching our goals.

Goals Met

The Provider Quality team worked diligently to increase timely documentation and improve provider satisfaction.

★ More than 90% of Family Care and Partnership members received direct contact from their care team staff every month.

★ More care team staff received quality training and evaluation to deliver high quality care management.

More vulnerable, high-risk members experienced timely face-to-face visits from their care team staff than in 2022.

★ Over 90% of Family Care members with a hypertension diagnosis had a blood pressure recorded timely in 2023.

Pneumococcal (pneumonia) and influenza (flu) vaccination rates for Family Care and Partnership members exceeded the prior year's statewide average.

Accomplishments

★ Creation of a new "Cultural Considerations" section within all Clinical Practice Guidelines.

FCP positive responses on the annual Member Satisfaction Survey Results increased across all survey questions.

New Critical Incident Dashboard monitoring tool developed.

★ MCOs across the state collaborated to create a Community Connections training curriculum.

MCW provided education on member wellness through social media postings and community outreach, including MCW vaccination billboards posted throughout various Wisconsin communities.
