Each year, the Quality Department develops a work plan with goals and outcomes for My Choice Wisconsin's Family Care & Partnership programs to achieve. The goals are chosen based on the results of the previous year's plan evaluation, internal and external audits, feedback from members/caregivers/provi ders and other data sources that may indicate the need to improve performance. The plan serves as a roadmap for corrective actions and Performance Improvement Projects, and it provides a tracking mechanism for Quality Department staff to monitor progress toward reaching our goals.
